3. BUNKERS
 - a) Stones in Bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1)
4. WASTE BUNKERS
 - a) Play ball as it lies. You may ground your club and remove loose impediments on the "waste bunker area" as the area is through the green.
5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR
 - a) Includes all vehicle marks, newly turfed and seeded areas, unfinished course work and all areas marked G.U.R. (Rule 25)
6. FIXED SPRINGLER HEADS
 - a) These are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under (Rule 24-2)
7. BUGGY PATHS
 - a) All buggy paths are immovable obstructions, relief can be taken under (Rule 24-2b)
8. DISTANCE MARKERS
 - a) These distances are measured to the center of each green.
9. SPEED OF PLAY
 - a) Please keep pace with the group in front.
10. Please repair all pitch marks on greens, smooth sand in the bunkers and replace any divots. All measurements of the holes are taken from the back of tee box to the centre of the green. Please check the individual sprinkler heads for specific distances to the centre of the green.
